The DHS Technology Clearinghouse is designed to meet the requirements established in Section 313 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (P L 107-296). It is an online web-service designed to provide direct support to emergency responders' technology needs, and be a "one-stop shop" for access to technology information for Federal, State, Tribal, and local public safety and first responder communities. The goal of this service is not to create content or applications, but rather to leverage available resources.

To accomplish its purpose, the Technology Clearinghouse supplies a single web-based point of entry, tying together information from many resources related to homeland security technologies, and programs for emergency programs. This information is enhanced with a search facility that encompasses all linked data.

The Technology Clearinghouse utilizes a concept based searching tool to rapidly deliver links to relevant results. This service provides information regarding, Technologies, Policies and Regulations, Standards and Guidelines, Training, Testing and Evaluation, Grants, Technical Assistance, and Lessons Learned/Best Practices.

Master File / Data:

System Data

The system contains links to, and descriptive information regarding, the externally available resources. Informational documents such as news reports, FAQs, and policy statements may be included.

Disposition:

a. Web-Service data. This includes links to data, graphics and copies of useful, related documents.

Temporary. Destroy or delete when superseded or no longer needed for business purposes.

b. Feedback Data. Suggestions on improving, or comments about the Technology Clearinghouse are submitted by visitors to the service via an online form.

Temporary. Destroy or delete one year after submission or when no longer needed for business purposes.
