The mission of the Office of Infrastructure Protection (OIP) is based on the requirements of the Homeland Security Act of 2002, The Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004, Homeland Security Presidential Directive (HSPD)-7, "Critical Infrastructure Identification, Prioritization, and Protection," Section 550 of the Fiscal Year 2007 Homeland Security Appropriations Act, HSPD-19, "Combating Terrorist Use of Explosives in the United States," and additional Executive Orders, HSPDs and National Security Presidential Directives

LENS (Linked Encrypted Network System) allows the Office of Infrastructure Protection/Protective Security Coordination Division personnel to coordinate and maintain information in support of their mission to reduce the risk of the nation's critical infrastructures and key resources of a terrorist attack by assessing vulnerabilities and consequences, and developing, implementing and providing national coordination for protective programs and facilitating CI/KR response and recovery operations in an all-hazards environment

It is designed to provide an introductory overview of the issues facing those charged with developing plans and programs to protect critical infrastructures and key assets.
